Schwinn 430: I'm having issues adjusting the incline on my elliptical

Follow this troubleshooting guide to help resolve incline issues on your Schwinn 430 Elliptical.

Some common complaints may include:

- Can't adjust incline/incline not working
- Incline handle won't move
- Incline handle won't lock into place

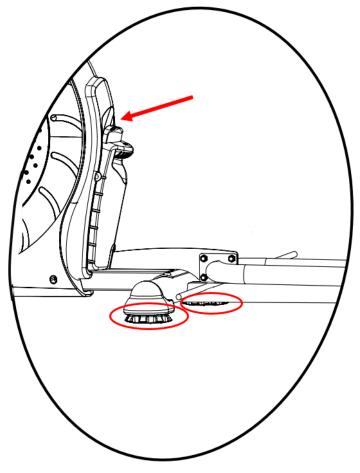
Follow these steps to troubleshoot the issue

Tools you may need: Phillips head screwdriver 6mm hex/Allen wrench, or the wrench from the hardware card included with your machine 13mm open-ended wrench

- 1. Check if your elliptical is set on a solid and level surface. Adjust the leveler feet as needed to level your machine [12754.A].
- Check all hardware installed during assembly, tightening as needed with a Phillips head screwdriver, 6mm Allen wrench, and 13mm open-ended wrench. Refer to the <u>assembly manual</u> for guidance on hardware to tighten [12754.B].
- 3. Inspect all plastic shrouds/covers and make sure they are aligned properly and secured to your machine. If needed, remove or loosen the hardware attaching the shrouds and adjust the shroud's position. Once properly aligned, reinstall/tighten the hardware to secure it [12754.C].
- 4. If the issue persists, adjust the leveler feet until there is a space between the top of the incline assembly and the main unit shroud (reference 1) that measures between 1/4" and 1/2" (6mm to 12.5mm) [12754.D].

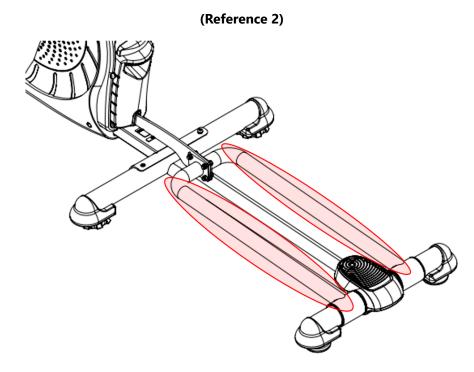
(Reference 1)

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Adjust the leveler feet until the space between the main shroud and incline motor measures between 1/4" and 1/2" (6mm to 12.5mm).

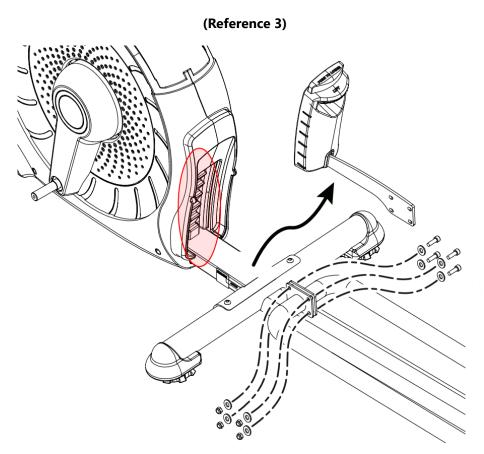
 Inspect the adjustable ramp assembly for damage (reference 2) and make sure that it is operating smoothly during the entire incline cycle. If damage is present or there are issues with smooth operation, <u>order an Adjustable Ramp</u> <u>Assembly [12754.E]</u>.



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Inspect the ramp assembly for damage and check for smooth operation during the incline cycle. The leg assemblies are not pictured for clarity.

- 6. If the issue persists, inspect the ratchet and ratchet handle assemblies (reference 3) for bends, breaks, or other damage that hinders or prevents proper incline operation. To inspect the ratchet assembly, remove the ratchet handle Refer to the <u>assembly manual</u> and work backward to Step 3 to remove other parts blocking access to the handle. You will need a 6mm Allen wrench and a 13mm open-ended wrench to perform these steps. Check that the handle can reach from the ramp to the ratchet and will set firmly into each ratchet slot. If the handle is damaged or will not set into the slots properly, <u>order a Ratchet Handle [12754.F]</u>. If the ratchet assembly is damaged or the issue persists, <u>order a Ratchet Assembly [12754.G]</u>.
 - *Please note*, <u>a crank puller is required to remove the main shroud and replace the ratchet assembly</u> (not required for ratchet handle replacement only). If you are replacing the ratchet assembly, <u>order a Crank Puller</u> if you do no already have one.



The ratchet assembly is circled in red and is located on the interior of the machine. The ratchet handle is the part detached from the machine in this image with the black arrow pointing to it.
